- RE: International Shipping Policy: Exports and Review of International Shipments

This memorandum introduces new policy and proco Eres p pos

Published works and personal correspondence are not subject to export controls and, therefore, can be shipped to international recipients without needing to submit an International Shipping Request Form, <u>unles</u> the total value of the shipment exceeds \$2499.

"Published works" include scholarly works (journals, individual articles, textbooks, presentation papers, publicly available theses and dissertations, posters etc.), published books, and similar printed material. Unpublished manuscripts may be subject to export controls if they contain research data not intended for publication, so consult with your export compliance coordinator prior to exporting these items.

"Personal correspondence" includes perso**aad** professional messages (letters to relatives, communication with a conference organizer etc.), and awards (certificates, plaques etc.).
